Suitable Shoes:

A reminder that children should not be coming to nursery school with open toed or open back shoes, this includes Crocs. Trainers and plimsolls are perfect.

Summer Garden Party:

We look forward to welcoming those parents who have booked their place at our summer garden party on Friday 3rd July. Please ensure you arrive on time at the gate, as no one will be in the reception area for latecomers.

Parent Consultations:

Thank you to those parents who have booked their meeting slot with their child's keyworker for Wednesday 8th July. A reminder that the nursery is closed to the child on this day. If you bring your child with you to the meeting, you must ensure that they stay with you and do not disturb the other meetings.

End of Year Rhyme Time:

On Tuesday 14th July 2026, parents are invited into nursery for our Summer "Rhyme Time". The start time for the morning session is 10:30am, and the afternoon session is 2:30pm. Entrance is via the garden gate, which will close at 10.40am and 2.40pm respectively. Please ensure you arrive on time, as late arrivals will not be admitted as it causes disruption for the children and other parents. A reminder will be sent nearer the time. 30hr parents can choose to attend whichever session they prefer, but if your child usually leaves at 2.30pm and you want to attend the 2.30pm Rhyme Time, please let Sarah know so that your child can remain in the classroom.

Last Day of Summer Term:

Friday 17th July 2026 is the last day of our Summer Term. We will be running shorter, adjusted session times on this day.

AM children's session time will be 8:30am to 10:30am

PM children's session time will be 11:00am to 1:00pm

30hr children can do 8:30am to 1:00pm, or choose to finish at 10:30am with the AM children. There will be no option to stay later than 1:00pm on this day. If you want to collect at another time, before 1pm, please let Sarah know, and she'll make sure your child is ready.

Full Time at Nursery School:

If your child is returning to our nursery in September 2026, and you want them to be considered for a full-time place, if both parents (or one parent of a single-parent family) are working, you can apply for a 'working parent funding code'. This code would allow them to do 8.30am to 2.30pm at our nursery, with the option of buying an extra hour until 3.30pm. You may also be eligible for the funding if one parent receives carers allowance, and the other parent is working (or if you are a single parent receiving carers allowance, you also need to be working). If this is something you may be interested in, please speak with Sarah in the school office.

In order for the funding to be in place for 1st September 2026, you must have applied successfully by 31st August 2026.
